As the first meeting was concerned, it started with a short presentation of each organization and the individual participants themselves. As there were just three partners, the presentation was efficient and it was easy to remember the information of all participants. It was nice to get to know each other little bit before starting other activities.

An interactive and very creative activity took place afterwards. It was a pair-work. Pairs were established across the partners' organizations (countries) what contributed to getting to know each other better and what also functioned as icebreaking tool. The task of each pair was to lead an interview and to write down its outcomes on these topics: "What are we looking for?", "My offer" and "I am..." The outcomes were written on small colourful papers and were placed on the wall, distributed according to the topics. Then, the outcomes were read loudly and were analyzed. It was a very nice input to the project and the outcomes were quite valuable. The work lied on creative activity which was based on spontaneous thoughts. Thanks to this kind of work, participants were brought closer to the project theme – CREATIVITY – by an informal way – the activity was thus sensitising towards the project content. The results of the works can be seen in the attached pictures.

The rest of the meeting was held in more "formal" way. The organizational matters were discussed: adaptation of the plan of activities to reduced number of partners; partnership contracts; creation of a project website; creation of a project leaflet; creation of a project logo – with help of questionnaires; adaptation of a feedback form for the meetings; creation of a questionnaire for educational and training organizations + planning of the survey and its evaluation. In the informal part of the meeting (during dinners), interesting discussions among the partners were led on various topics, especially on themes related to history, culture, and politics. Thus, informal learning took place also out of the official meeting session, too.
